


- A: Endocervical curettings

FINAL DIAGNOSIS


- A. Endocervical curettings:
Benign lower uterine segment and endometrium.
 - B. Endometrial curettings:
Secretory phase endometrium.
 - C. Right uterosacral ligament, biopsy:
FibroadiPOSE tissue within normal limits.
 - D. Portion of left ovary:
Ovarian parenchyma within normal limits.
 - E. Left cul de sac, biopsy:
Involved by endometriosis.

GROSS DESCRIPTION

The specimen is received in 5 parts.

Part A is labeled as "endocervical curettage". Received in formalin is/are multiple pieces of white mucous material measuring 4.0 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.





Part B is labeled as "endometrial curettage". Received in formalin is/are multiple dusky brown hemorrhagic material measuring 4.5 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.

Part C, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 1.0 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.

Part D, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 1.5 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.

Part E, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 0.8 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.
