### SPECIMEN(S) RECEIVED

- A: Endocervical curettings
- B: Endometrial curettings
- C: Cervical biopsy 5 o'clock
- D: Right ovarian lesion


### CLINICAL INFORMATION

Metabolic syndrome X, perimenopausal state, menometrorrhagia, abnormal cervical pap smear secondary.

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### FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Endocervical curettings:  
Mixture of endometrial and cervical tissue within normal limits.
  - B. Endometrial curettings:  
Disordered proliferative endometrium.
  - C. Cervical 5:00, biopsy:  
Cervical squamous epithelium within normal limits.
  - D. Right ovarian lesion, excision:  
Hemorrhagic corpus luteum cyst.
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### GROSS DESCRIPTION

The specimen is received in four parts.

Part A, received in formalin is (are) multiple piece(s) of tan white soft tissue measuring 3.5 cm. in greatest dimension/or aggregate. Entirely submitted in A1.

Part B, received in formalin is (are) multiple piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 2.5 mm. in greatest dimension/or aggregate. Entirely submitted in B1.

Part C, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of white soft tissue measuring 1.0 cm. in greatest dimension/or aggregate. Entirely submitted in C1.



Part D, received in formalin is (are) 3 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 1.0cm. in greatest dimension/or aggregate. Entirely submitted in D1.

**MICROSCOPIC DESCRIPTION**
