### PRE OP DIAGNOSIS

Pelvic pain, irregular menstruation, endometriosis of pelvic peritoneum

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### FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Endocervical curettings:  
Cervical tissue within normal limits.
- B. Endometrial curettings:  
Benign endometrium within normal limits.
- C. Portion of right ovary, excision:  
Hemorrhagic corpus luteum cyst.

### GROSS DESCRIPTION

The specimen is received in 3 parts.

Part A is labeled as "endocervical curettage". Received in formalin is/are multiple pieces of white mucous material measuring 1 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.

Part B is labeled as "endometrial curettage". Received in formalin is/are multiple dusky brown hemorrhagic material measuring 2 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.
