## Diagnosis

A. LEFT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:

ELASTOTIC SCAR WITH DYSTROPHIC MINERALIZATION.

B. LEFT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM, EXCISION:

NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

C. UTERINE TISSUE, EXCISION:

FRAGMENTS OF SMOOTH MUSCLE, CONSISTENT WITH UTERINE LEIOMYOMA.

## **Gross Description**

A. In formalin labeled "left ovarian fossa" is a 0.5 cm tan tissue fragment. Entirely, one block.

- B. In formalin labeled "left periureteral" is a 1.5  $\times$  1  $\times$  0.2 cm tan tissue fragment. The specimen is sectioned and entirely submitted, one block.
- C. In formalin labeled "uterine tissue" is a 4 x 4 x 2 cm aggregate of pink-tan and focally cauterized soft tissue fragments. Sampled, 3 blocks.
