FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Right bladder flap, biopsy:
- Fibroadipose tissue with focal foreign-body giant cell reaction
 - Negative for carcinoma
- B. Right pelvic sidewall:
- Fibroadipose tissue with focal foreign-body giant cell reaction
 - Negative for carcinoma

Note: Immunohistochemical stain shows that AE1/E3 highlights mesothelial cells.
