
PRE OP DIAGNOSIS

Superficial endometriosis of anterior cul de sac, irregular menstruation

FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Endocervical curettings:
Small fragments of lower uterine segment within normal limits.
- B. Endometrial curettings:
Mixture of endometrium and cervical tissue within normal limits.
- C. Right uterosacra ligament lesion, biopsy:
Involved by endometriosis.
- D. Right cul de sac, biopsy:
Involved by endometriosis.
- E. Right fallopian tube cyst, excision:
Simple paratubal cyst.

GROSS DESCRIPTION



The specimen is received in 5 parts.

Part A is labeled as "endocervical curettage". Received in formalin is/are 1 pieces of white mucous material measuring 0.6 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.

Part B is labeled as "endometrial curettage". Received in formalin is/are multiple dusky brown hemorrhagic material measuring 0.7 cm in aggregate. Entirely submitted.

Part C, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 0.7 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.

Part D, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 1.0 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.

Part E, received in formalin is (are) 2 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 1.0 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.
