A. LEFT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM, EXCISION:
MILD SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

B. BLADDER FLAP, EXCISION:
SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

C. CERVIX, EXCISION:
BENIGN FIBROMUSCULAR STROMA.
FIBROMEMBRANOUS TISSUE, CONSISTENT WITH PERITONEAL ADHESION.

D. RIGHT BLADDER FLAP, EXCISION:
GRANULOMATOUS PERITONITIS.

E. RIGHT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:
NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

F. RIGHT OVARY, EXCISION:
HEMORRHAGIC CORPUS LUTEUM CYST.

Gross Description

A. In formalin labeled "left periureteral": 1, 1.5 x 1 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.

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Gross Description

B. In formalin labeled "bladder flap": 1, 0.5 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

C. In formalin labeled "cervix": 2, 0.4-0.7 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

D. In formalin labeled "right bladder flap": 1, 0.5 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

~~E. In formalin labeled "right ovarian fossa": 1, 0.7 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.~~

F. In formalin labeled "right ovary" is a 4.5 x 2.5 x 2 cm fragmented ovary sectioned to reveal a possible, 3 cm greatest dimension collapsed cyst lined by congested cut surfaces. Sectioning of the remaining ovary demonstrates pink-tan ovarian tissue. Sampled, 3 blocks. [REDACTED]
