Diagnosis

A. CYST, VULVA, EXCISION:

EPIDERMOID CYST.

B. ENDOCERVIX, CURETTINGS:

PROLIFERATIVE ENDOMETRIUM AND SUPERFICIAL MYOMETRIUM. ENDOCERVIX NOT PRESENT FOR EVALUATION.

C. ENDOMETRIUM, CURETTINGS:

PROLIFERATIVE ENDOMETRIUM.

SUPERFICIAL MYOMETRIUM WITH ADENOMYOSIS.

ENDOCERVICAL GLANDULAR MUCOSA WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

D. UTERINE FIBROID, EXCISION:

LEIOMYOMA UTERI.

E. LEFT OVARIAN ENDOMETRIOMA, EXCISION:

ENDOMETRIOSIS/ENDOMETRIOMA.

F. RIGHT FALLOPIAN TUBE CYST, EXCISION:

BENIGN SEROUS PARATUBAL CYST.

G. LEFT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:

ENDOMETRIOSIS.

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Gross Description

- A. In formalin labeled "vulvar cyst" is a $0.8 \times 0.5 \times 0.4$ cm, ragged portion of tan-white tissue. Totally submitted, one block.
- B. In formalin labeled "endocervical curetting" is a 1.5 \times 0.4 \times 0.3 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with mucus. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- C. In formalin labeled "endometrial curetting" is a 2 \times 2 \times 0.4 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with clotted blood. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "uterine fibroid" is a $0.6 \times 0.3 \times$
- E. In formalin labeled "left ovarian endometrioma" is a $2.2 \times 1.4 \times 0.4$ cm portion of tissue that is tan-brown and rubbery on one side and tan-gray, predominantly smooth on the other side. Specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, one block.
- F. In formalin labeled "right fallopian tube cyst" is a 1.0 \times 0.3 \times 0.3 cm portion of tan-purple tissue remarkable for a 0.3 cm, gray, semitranslucent cyst filled with clear serous fluid. Totally submitted, one block.
- G. In formalin labeled "left ovarian fossa" is a 1.0 \times 0.4 0.3 cm portion of tan-brown, firm tissue. Totally submitted, one block.
