C. LEFT UTEROSACRAL LIGAMENT, EXCISION:
SMALL FRAGMENT OF DISTORTED SMOOTH MUSCLE.

D. PELVIC CUL-DE-SAC, EXCISION:
SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

E. RIGHT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:
SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

F. RIGHT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM:
ENDOMETRIOSIS.

G. OMENTUM, EXCISION:
ENDOMETRIOSIS.

H. UTERUS, BILATERAL FALLOPIAN TUBES AND LEFT OVARY, EXCISION:
EXTENSIVELY AUTOLYZED ENDOMETRIUM.

SEROSAL ENDOMETRIOSIS AND SALPINGITIS ISTHMICA NODOSA, LEFT FALLOPIAN TUBE.
SEROSAL ENDOMETRIOSIS WITH ADHESIONS AND CYSTIC FOLLICLES, LEFT OVARY.

- A. In formalin labeled "rectal wall": 1, 1.1 x 0.8 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- B. In formalin labeled "left periureteral": 1, 0.9 x 0.5 x 0.3 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- C. In formalin labeled "left uterosacral ligament": 1, 0.4 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1, 0.9 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- E. In formalin labeled "right ovarian fossa": 1, 1 x 0.6 x 0.6 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- F. In formalin labeled "right periureteral": 1, 1.6 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- G. In formalin labeled "omentum": 1, 1.1 x 0.6 x 0.3 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- H. In formalin labeled "uterus bilateral fallopian tubes left ovary" is a supracervical uterus with amputated adnexa indicated as left per requisition and amputated tube. Without adnexa, the 82 g uterus is 6.3 cm fundus to lower uterine segment, 5 cm cornu to cornu, 4 cm anterior to posterior. The serosa is tan-pink and smooth. The endometrial cavity is 5 x 2.3 cm with pink-red, 0.1 cm thick endometrium. The myometrium is tan-pink, trabeculated, and ranges from 1.4-2.1 cm thickness. The right fimbriated fallopian tube is 5 x 1.2 cm tan-purple, smooth serosa. Sectioning reveals a pinpoint lumen. The left fimbriated fallopian tube is 6.2 x 1 cm with gritty tan-purple, smooth serosa. Sectioning reveals a pinpoint lumen. The 4 g left ovary is 3 x 2 x 1.7 cm and has a tan-purple outer surface. Sectioning reveals unremarkable cut surfaces. Sampled as follows: 1-2-uterine wall, 3-endomyometrium, 4-6-right fallopian tube, 7-9-left fallopian tube, 10-12-left ovary.
