Diagnosis

A. LEFT FALLOPIAN TUBE AND OVARY, EXCISION:

FALLOPIAN TUBE WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.
OVARY WITH ENDOMETRIOSIS AND CYSTIC FOLLICLES.

B. LEFT PELVIC SIDEWALL, EXCISION:

MILD SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

C. LEFT ILIAC PERITONEUM, EXCISION:

FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

D. LEFT ROUND LIGAMENT, EXCISION:

FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

E. PELVIC CUL-DE-SAC, EXCISION:

FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

Gross Description

A. In formalin labeled "left fallopian tube and ovary" is a 4.7 x 0.6 cm fimbriated fallopian tube surfaced by tan unremarkable serosa. There is also a separate 3.5 x 2.3 x 2.1 cm ovary, sectioned to reveal multiple unilocular cystic spaces ranging from 0.1 up to 0.5 cm greatest dimension filled with clear serous, clear gelatinous, or dark red-brown material. There are no masses or papillary excrescences identified. Sampled, 2 blocks.

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Gross Description

B. In formalin labeled "left pelvic sidewall": 1, 1.1 x 0.7 x 0.6 cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block.

C. In formalin labeled "left iliac": 1, 0.7 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.

D. In formalin labeled "left round ligament": 1, 1.0 x 0.9 x 0.3 cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block.

E. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1.0 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block. GCS/JRW
