Diagnosis

A. LEFT FALLOPIAN TUBE AND OVARY, EXCISION:

FALLOPIAN TUBE WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY. OVARY WITH ENDOMETRIOSIS AND CYSTIC FOLLICLES.

B. LEFT PELVIC SIDEWALL, EXCISION:

MILD SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

C. LEFT ILIAC PERITONEUM, EXCISION: FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

D. LEFT ROUND LIGAMENT, EXCISION: FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

E. PELVIC CUL-DE-SAC, EXCISION: FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

Gross Description

A. In formalin labeled "left fallopian tube and ovary" is a 4.7 \times 0.6 cm fimbriated fallopian tube surfaced by tan unremarkable serosa. There is also a separate 3.5 \times 2.3 \times 2.1 cm ovary, sectioned to reveal multiple unilocular cystic spaces ranging from 0.1 up to 0.5 cm greatest dimension filled with clear serous, clear gelatinous, or dark red-brown material. There are no masses or papillary excrescences identified. Sampled, 2 blocks.

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Gross Description

- B. In formalin labeled "left pelvic sidewall": 1, $1.1 \times 0.7 \times 0.6$ cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
- C. In formalin labeled "left iliac": 1, $0.7 \times 0.6 \times 0.2$ cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "left round ligament": 1, 1.0 \times 0.9 \times 0.3 cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
- E. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1.0 \times 0.6 \times 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Trisected and totally submitted, 1 block. GCS/JRW
