Diagnosis

A. COLONIC ADHESIONS, EXCISION:

FIBROMEMBRANOUS TISSUE, CONSISTENT WITH PERITONEAL ADHESIONS.

B. LEFT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM, EXCISION:

ENDOMETRIOSIS.

Gross Description

- A. Received in formalin labeled "colonic adhesions" is a 3.1 cm long portion of tan-grey membranous tissue with a 0.2 cm diameter, grossly consistent with an adhesion. Sectioned and entirely submitted, 1 block.
- B. Received in formalin labeled "left periureteral" is a 1.0 \times 0.7 \times 0.2 cm portion of tan membranous tissue. The resection margin is inked black. Specimen is sectioned and entirely submitted, 1 block.
