- A. Uterus, supracervical hysterectomy:  
- Endometriosis involving uterine serosa  
- Proliferative endometrium
- B. Fallopian tube, left, salpingectomy:  
- Unremarkable fallopian tube
- C. Fallopian tube, right, salpingectomy:  
- Unremarkable fallopian tube

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### GROSS DESCRIPTION

A. Received in formalin labeled "uterus" is a supracervical hysterectomy specimen that is devoid of adnexa. The uterus weighs 138 g and measures 7.5 cm from superior to inferior, 5.0 cm from cornu to cornu, and 5.5 cm from anterior to posterior. The serosa is tan-gray and predominantly smooth with focal adhesions on the posterior surface. The uterus is bivalved to demonstrate a triangular endometrial cavity that measures 4.4 x 3.3 cm and is lined by pink-tan endometrium that measures 0.5 cm thick. Sectioning reveals tan, densely trabeculated myometrium that has a greatest thickness of 2.5 cm. No intramural or subserosal nodules are grossly identified. Representative sections are submitted in five cassettes as follows:

A1-serosal slivers  
A2-A3-anterior endomyometrium  
A4-A5-posterior endomyometrium

B. Received in formalin labeled "left fallopian tube" is an intact fimbriated fallopian tube that measures 7.0 cm in length by 0.6 cm in diameter. The serosa is tan-gray and smooth. Sectioning reveals a complete lumen. Representative sections are submitted in one cassette.

C. Received in formalin labeled "right fallopian tube" is an intact fimbriated fallopian tube that measures 7.2 cm in length by 0.8 cm in diameter. The serosa is tan-gray, smooth, and remarkable for two cysts that measure 0.2 and 0.8 cm in greatest dimension. Sectioning reveals a complete lumen.
