Diagnosis

A. ENDOCERVIX, CURETTINGS:

ENDOCERVICAL GLANDULAR MUCOSA WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.
SCANT INACTIVE LOWER UTERINE SEGMENT ENDOMETRIUM.

B. ENDOMETRIUM, CURETTINGS:

DISRUPTED MID SECRETORY PHASE ENDOMETRIUM.

C. ADHESED LEFT DISTAL TUBE, EXCISION:

FALLOPIAN TUBE WITH SALPINGITIS ISTHMICA NODOSA AND SURFACE SEROSAL ADHESIONS.

D. RECTAL WALL, EXCISION:

FOCAL ENDOMETRIOSIS.

E. FOREIGN BODY, EXCISION/EXTRACTION:

ORGANIZED FAT NECROSIS, SUGGESTIVE OF INFARCTED EPIPLOIC APPENDAGE.

F. RIGHT OVARY, PARTIAL EXCISION:

HEMORRHAGIC CORPUS LUTEUM.

G. RIGHT FALLOPIAN TUBE CYST, EXCISION:

BENIGN SEROUS PARATUBAL CYST.

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Gross Description

A. In formalin labeled "endocervical curetting" is a 0.9 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with mucus. Totally submitted, 1 block.

B. In formalin labeled "endometrial curetting" is a 2.8 x 1.7 x 0.9 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with clotted blood. Totally submitted, 3 blocks.

C. In formalin labeled "adhesed left distal tube" is a 2.6 x 0.6 cm portion of fimbriated fallopian tube surface by tan-pink unremarkable serosa. Sectioning reveals an intact pinpoint lumen. Totally submitted, 2 blocks.

D. In formalin labeled "rectal wall": 1, 0.6 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

E. In formalin labeled "foreign body" is a 1.5 x 1.2 x 0.2 cm oval portion of tan- white membranous material. Sectioning reveals a unilocular cystic space containing yellow granular material. The wall thickness is 1.0 cm and are no masses or excrescences identified. Totally submitted, 1 block.

F. In formalin labeled "portion of right ovary": 1, 1.5 x 0.9 x 0.6 cm tissue piece(s). Sectioned and totally submitted, 1 block.

G. In formalin labeled "right fallopian tube cyst": 1, 0.7 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block. [REDACTED]
