Diagnosis

A. ENDOCERVIX, CURETTINGS:

SCANT DISRUPTED ENDOCERVICAL GLANDULAR MUCOSA WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

B. ENDOMETRIUM, CURETTINGS:

SECRETORY ENDOMETRIUM.

C. LEFT FALLOPIAN TUBE CYST, EXCISION:

BENIGN SEROUS PARATUBAL CYST.

D. LEFT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:

ENDOMETRIOSIS.

E. LEFT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM, EXCISION:

MILD SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS WITH SPARSE CHRONIC INFLAMMATION.

Gross Description

A. In formalin labeled "endocervical curettings" is a 1.0 x 1.0 x 0.1 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with mucus. Totally submitted, 1 block.

B. In formalin labeled "endometrial curettings" is a 2.5 x 2.1 x 0.4 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with blood. Totally submitted, 1 block.

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Gross Description

C. In formalin labeled "left fallopian tube cyst": 1, 0.6 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

D. In formalin labeled "left ovarian fossa": 1, 0.8 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.

E. In formalin labeled "left periureteral": 1, 0.5 x 0.4 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block. GCS/JRW
