### Diagnosis

A. ENDOCERVIX, CURETTINGS:

ENDOCERVICAL GLANDULAR MUCOSA WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

B. ENDOMETRIUM, CURETTINGS:

SCANT INACTIVE/WEAKLY PROLIFERATIVE ENDOMETRIUM.
ENDOCERVICAL GLANDULAR MUCOSA WITH NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

- C. RIGHT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM, EXCISION: ENDOMETRIOSIS.
- D. RIGHT FALLOPIAN TUBE CYST, EXCISION: FIBROMEMBRANOUS TISSUE, SUGGESTIVE OF PERITONEAL ADHESION.
- E. RIGHT UTEROSACRAL LIGAMENT, EXCISION: MILD SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.
- F. PELVIC CUL-DE-SAC, EXCISION: NO SIGNIFICANT HISTOPATHOLOGIC ABNORMALITY.

### **Gross Description**

- B. In formalin labeled "EMC" is a 2.0  $\times$  0.8  $\times$  0.9 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with blood. Totally submitted, 2 blocks.
- C. In formalin labeled "right periureteral": 1, 0.6 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "right fallopian tube cyst": 1, polypoid 1.0  $\times$  0.1 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- E. In formalin labeled "right ureteral sacral ligament": 1,  $0.6 \times 0.3 \times 0.2$  cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
- F. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1, 0.6 x 0.5 x 0.3 cm tissue piece(s). Bisected and totally submitted, 1 block.
