C. RIGHT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM:
SURFACE PERITONEAL ADHESIONS.
PORTION OF OVARIAN CORTEX.

D. RIGHT OVARY, EXCISION:
FRAGMENTED OVARY WITH STROMAL LUTEINIZATION.

E. RIGHT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION:
SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

A. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1, 0.6 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.

B. In formalin labeled "left ovarian cyst": 2.5 x 1 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.

C. In formalin labeled "right periureteral": 2 x 1.5 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.

D. In formalin labeled "right ovary": 2.5 x 2 x 1 cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 3 blocks.

E. In formalin labeled "right ovarian fossa": 1, 1 x 0.5 x 0.1 cm tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block. [REDACTED]
