- A. PELVIC CUL-DE-SAC, EXCISION: GRANULOMATOUS PERITONITIS.
- B. LEFT OVARIAN CYST, EXCISION: CYSTIC CORPUS LUTEUM.
- C. RIGHT PERIURETERAL PERITONEUM: SURFACE PERITONEAL ADHESIONS. PORTION OF OVARIAN CORTEX.
- D. RIGHT OVARY, EXCISION: FRAGMENTED OVARY WITH STROMAL LUTEINIZATION.
- E. RIGHT OVARIAN FOSSA, EXCISION: SUBPERITONEAL FIBROSIS.

Gross Description

- A. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 1, 0.6 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- B. In formalin labeled "left ovarian cyst": $2.5 \times 1 \times 0.2$ cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.

- C. In formalin labeled "right periureteral": $2 \times 1.5 \times 0.2$ cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "right ovary": $2.5 \times 2 \times 1$ cm aggregate of tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 3 blocks.
- E. In formalin labeled "right ovarian fossa": 1, 1 \times 0.5 \times 0.1 cm tissue piece(s). The specimen is sectioned. Totally submitted, 1 block.
