



grossly identified. The left adnexa consists of a fimbriated fallopian tube that measures 6.2 cm in length by 0.5 cm in diameter and an ovary that measures 2.3 x 1.1 x 0.8 cm. The fallopian tube serosa is gray-purple and smooth. Sectioning reveals a complete lumen. The external surface of the ovary is tan-gray, smooth, and glistening. Sectioning reveals tan, grossly unremarkable ovarian parenchyma. Representative sections are submitted in 10 cassettes as follows:

- A1-AA2-full-thickness anterior uterine wall
- A3-A4-full-thickness posterior uterine wall to include entire polypoid nodule
- A5-right fallopian tube
- A6-right ovary
- A7-left fallopian tube
- A8-left ovary
- A9-anterior cervix
- A10-posterior cervix

B. Received in formalin labeled "cul-de-sac" are two tan-yellow soft tissue fragments, 0.5 x 0.3 cm and 0.8 x 0.6 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.
