- A. In formalin labeled "endocervical curetting" is a 1 x 0.2 x 0.1 cm portion of tissue fragment. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- B. In formalin labeled "endometrial curetting" is a 3 x 1.5 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with clotted blood. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- C. In formalin labeled "right uterus sacral ligament": 1, 0.7 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "right cul-de-sac": 1, 0.5 x 0.4 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- E. In formalin labeled "left ovarian fossa": 1, 1 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- F. In formalin labeled "left fallopian tube cyst": 1, one, 0.7 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm collapsed cyst with attached 1.5 x 0.2 cm stalk. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- G. In formalin labeled "left cul-de-sac": 1, 0.5 x 0.4 x 0.2 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block. ■
