A. In formalin labeled "endocervical curettings": 1.5 x 1 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue pieces and mucus. Totally submitted, 1 block.

B. In formalin labeled "endometrial curettings": 2 x 2 x 0.3 cm aggregate of tissue pieces and clotted blood. Totally submitted, 1 block.

C. In formalin labeled "right bladder flap": 1, 0.5 cm tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
