


### PRE OP DIAGNOSIS

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### FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Left fallopian tube cyst, cystectomy:  
- Paratubal cyst
- B. Left ovarian capsule, biopsy:  
- Fibrous tissue with focal inflammation and reactive changes
- C. Left adnexal adhesion, biopsy:  
- Fibrous tissue with features suggestive of endometriosis
- D. Right peri-ureter, biopsy:  
- Fibroadipose tissue with focal mesothelial hyperplasia and reactive changes
- E. Right uretero-sacral ligament, biopsy:  
- Fibroadipose tissue with focal reactive changes
- F. Pelvic cyst, cystectomy:  
- Peritoneal inclusion cyst

**GROSS DESCRIPTION**

A. Received in formalin "left fallopian tube cyst" is a 0.4 x 0.2 x 0.2 cm gray-tan ovoid fragment. A distinct cyst is not identified grossly. The specimen is submitted in its entirety in one cassette.

B. Received in formalin "left ovarian capsule" is a 0.4 x 0.3 x 0.1 cm gray-tan ovoid fragment with a central punctate dark brown circumscribed focus of discoloration. Specimen is submitted in its entirety in one cassette.

C. Received in formalin "left adnexal-adhesion" is a gray elongated membranous appearing fragment measuring 0.6 x 0.2 x 0.2 cm. Submitted in its entirety in one cassette.

D. Received in formalin "right peri ureteral" is a yellow somewhat oval rubbery and lobulated fragment measuring 1.1 x 1.0 x 0.4 cm. One surface is excavated brown roughened with cautery artifact. No other lesions are seen. Trisected and entirely submitted in one cassette.

E. Received in formalin "right uretero sacral ligament" is an oval rubbery glistening fragment measuring 0.7 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm. One surface is pink-brown and membranous. The opposing aspect is brown-yellow and lobulated. Hemisected longitudinally and entirely submitted in one cassette.

F. Received in formalin "pelvic cyst" is a gray translucent partially collapsed cystic structure measuring 1.5 x 0.8 x 0.2 cm. Submitted in its entirety in 1 cassette.
