FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Bilateral ovaries, bilateral oophorectomy:
 - Unremarkable ovaries
- B. Left ovarian fossa, biopsy:
 - Benign fibrous tissue with mesothelial lining
- C. Cul de sac, biopsy:
 - Fibrous tissue with focal mesothelial hyperplasia

GROSS DESCRIPTION

The specimen is received in 3 parts.

Part A, received in formalin is (are) 2 tan ovaries, one measuring 3.4 x 2.2 cm and the other one measuring 3 x 2 cm. Rep submitted in A1-2.

Part B, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 3.2 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.

Part C, received in formalin is (are) 1 piece(s) of pale tan soft tissue measuring 0.7 cm. in greatest dimension. Entirely submitted.
