

FINAL DIAGNOSIS

- A. Left adnexal adhesion, biopsy:
 - Fibroadipose tissue with focal chronic inflammation
 - B. Left ovarian fossa, biopsy:
 - Fibroadipose tissue with focal lymphoplasmacytic inflammation
 - C. Left peri-ureteral biopsy:
 - Fibroadipose tissue with focal benign mesothelial hyperplasia
 - D. Right peri-ureteral biopsy:
 - Fibroadipose tissue with focal benign mesothelial hyperplasia
 - E. Right cul-de-sac, biopsy:
 - Endosalpingiosis involving fibroadipose tissue
 - Focal foreign body-type giant cell reaction
 - F. Midline cul-de-sac, biopsy:
 - Benign fibroadipose tissue
 - G. Right pelvic sidewall, biopsy:
 - Endosalpingiosis involving fibroadipose tissue

GROSS DESCRIPTION

A. Received in formalin labeled "left adnexal adhesion" is a pale tan strip of soft tissue that measures 1.2 x 0.3 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.

B. Received in formalin labeled "left ovarian fossa" is a tan-gray soft tissue fragment, 0.8 x 0.7 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.

C. Received in formalin labeled "left peri ureteral" is a pale tan soft tissue fragment, 0.5 x 0.5 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.

D. Received in formalin labeled "right periureteral" is a pale tan soft tissue fragment, 2.0 x 1.5 cm. The specimen is sectioned and entirely submitted in one cassette.

E. Received in formalin labeled "right cul-de-sac" is a yellow-tan soft tissue fragment, 0.5 x 0.5 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.

F. Received in formalin labeled "midline cul de sac" is a yellow-tan fatty tissue fragment, 0.5 x 0.4 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette.

G. Received in formalin labeled "right pelvic sidewall" is a yellow-tan fatty tissue fragment, 1.0 x 0.8 cm. Entirely submitted in one cassette. (AC)
