



**GROSS DESCRIPTION**

The specimen is received in formalin in specimen containers each labeled with patient's name and medical record number.

Part A, is labeled" endocervical curetings." It consists of a 0.6 cm in greatest dimension fragment of tan-pink soft tissue admixed with gelatinous material. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette A1.

Part B, is labeled" intrauterine contents." It consists of a multiple irregular fragments of tan-pink soft tissue admixed with dark red clotted blood measuring 3.0 x 2.0 x 0.5 cm in aggregate. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette B1.

Part C, is labeled" right uterosacral ligament." It consists of three irregular tan-pink rubbery tissue fragments measuring 0.1 -0.4 cm in greatest dimension. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette D1.

Part D, is labeled" ovarian fossa." It consists of a 0.5 cm in greatest dimension tan-pink soft tissue fragment. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette D1.

Part E, is labeled" right periureteral." It consists of a 0.6 cm greatest dimension tan-pink soft tissue fragment. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette E1.

Part F, is labeled" Left fallopian tube cyst." It consists of a 0.8 x 0.5 x 0.5 cm pedunculated cyst. It is bisected to reveal a unilocular cavity filled with translucent fluid. The specimen is entirely submitted in cassette F1.

Part G, is labeled" uterine fibroids." It consists of 69.9 g, 6.5 x 4.0 x 4.0 cm mostly intact firm mass. The outer surface is remarkable for a 3.0 cm in greatest in dimension focal area of disruption (inked blue). The specimen is serially sectioned to reveal mostly tan-yellow, sebaceous material and focal areas of white whorled fibrous cut surfaces. Representative sections are submitted in cassettes G1-G6

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
